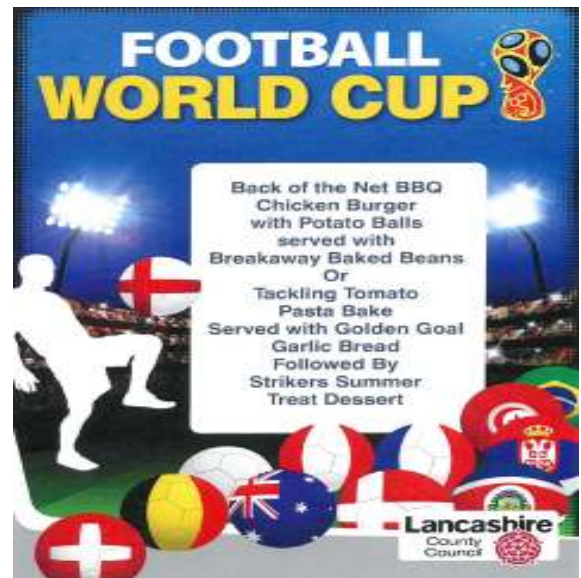


Sports Day
