School Walk – NEW DATE

Unfortunately, due to the predicted weather forecast of heavy rain for tomorrow, we have taken the decision to move the school walk to Thursday, when hopefully the weather will be drier.

We will be leaving school straight after registration. Packed lunches will still be provided for those that have ordered them (this includes all of Reception, Year 1 & 2).

The children should wear school PE kit on the day with old trainers or walking boots. Long trousers are advised as there are a lot of horse flies around.

The children will require a rucksack on the day which will need to carry the following:

- Packed lunch if you are providing one OR a suitable sized plastic lunch box (not lunch bag) for us to put the school packed lunch in (please see photograph of examples)
- A small plastic bag for children to sit on
- Sufficient water for the day
- Medication (e.g. inhaler) where applicable
- Please pack a lightweight packable coat if possible
- Suntan lotion and a sun hat (please apply suntan lotion in the morning before coming to school)

Sports Day



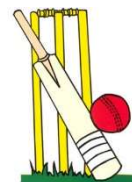
