School Uniform Policy
July 2017

This policy was written the Headteacher and Senior Leadership Team and adopted by the Governing Body of Ribchester St. Wilfrid's C of E Primary School in November 2017.

OUR MISSION STATEMENT:

- Jesus said: **“Love one another as I have loved you”** and this is our guiding principle. St Wilfrid's is a supportive family and in striving to love God we care about each other, our work and ourselves.

- All children should have equal access to all areas of the curriculum and are encouraged to love learning both here and beyond.

OUR AIMS

- To provide opportunities to develop co-operation, teamwork, trust and positive relationships with others.
- To educate children in a learning environment, which is safe, secure and enjoys the confidence of both child and parents.
- To provide many and varied first hand learning experiences to maximise the development of lively, enquiring and imaginative children.
- We recognise that each child has different abilities and talents and aim to provide equal access for all to the curriculum.
- We recognise the crucial role of parents/carers in the education process and aim to provide mutually supportive conditions for home/school links.
- To develop their physical, mental, social, and spiritual growth and help them grow in the understanding of, and in sympathy with, the Christian teaching.
- To provide opportunities for children to direct their own learning and make choices that encourage independence and a sense of responsibility, preparing them for adult life.

SCHOOL UNIFORM

Our school uniform shows that we are all part of St Wilfrid's school family. It fosters a strong feeling of belonging amongst the children. We actively encourage the wearing of school uniform as it is an important and contributory factor in the atmosphere, ethos and tradition of the school. Pride in appearance and cleanliness is encouraged at all times.

School uniform is worn by all our pupils and is welcomed by our parents.

AUTUMN / SPRING TERM

Girls:

Red sweatshirt / cardigan **with school logo**

Red polo shirt

Navy skirt/.pinafore or navy tailored trousers*

Tights: red or navy

Socks: white, navy or red

Boys:

Red sweatshirt **with school logo**

Red polo shirt

Navy school trousers*

Socks: grey or black

SUMMER TERM

Girls:

Red & white check gingham dresses

Red polo shirt

Navy skirt or navy tailored trousers*

Socks: white, navy or red

Boys:

Red polo shirt

Navy school trousers or navy shorts*

Socks: grey or black

***Please note leggings, casual trousers, joggers, etc. are not permitted.**

FOOTWEAR

Sensible black shoes only (Winter)

Sensible black school shoes or sensible sandals (Summer)

Trainers, boots or shoes with high heels must not be worn

The children in the Reception class should be provided with a pair of wellington boots. This should be kept in school all year round.

PE KIT

Sport plays an important role in the life of St Wilfrid's. The children are expected to change for PE. All clothing should be clearly named.

The PE Kit consists of:

Indoor P.E. kit

Plain red T shirt

Navy blue shorts

Black pumps

Outdoor P.E. kit

Navy / Black tracksuit bottoms

Navy / Black sweatshirt or jacket

Trainers

School PE Kit should be kept in a draw-string bag for storing and kept in school. These will be sent home at the end of each half term to be washed.

PE bags are available with the school name and logo on.

It is important that all items of clothing are named, including shoes, wellingtons and pumps.

COATS AND HATS

The children should bring a coat to school each day. School coats are available from school, but they are optional. In cold weather pupils may wear hats, gloves and scarves to protect them from the weather. Likewise, in the summer months, sun hats and caps should be provided to protect them from the sunshine.

HAIR

We expect all children to have a tidy appearance in school. Hair must be groomed and tidy. For reasons of hygiene and safety, long hair must be tied back. Hairstyles such as steps, Mohicans, shaved heads, shaved lines, steps and shaved sections are not allowed. Hair accessories should be simple and not present a safety risk. Imitation hair braids, hair jewellery and extensions are not allowed. School colours are preferable.

JEWELLERY

For safety reasons the wearing of jewellery is not considered suitable for normal school activities and must not be worn or brought into school. If children have their ears pierced it should be done at the beginning of the summer holidays as the earrings cannot be removed for six weeks. Earrings should be a small stud. Children are allowed to wear a wrist watch.

OTHER

Make up, fake tans, nail-varnish, fake tattoos and sprays are not permitted. Deodorant sprays can cause serious reactions to other children. If deodorant is needed to be used, then this should be roll-on which is not shared with others. Nails should be kept short. False nails are banned for safety reasons.

LOST PROPERTY

The best way to try and ensure items of uniform are not lost or mixed up is to have them clearly marked with your child's name and class. Every effort will be made to return lost property to the owner. All lost items will remain in the lost property box for at least half a term. At the end of each half term lost property will be collected up from cloak rooms and classrooms. During the first week of the new half term a table will be put outside, or in the porch at the end of each school day, with lost items for collection. Thereafter any uncollected items will be removed.

NAME IDENTIFICATION

All items of clothing should be clearly marked with your child's name. This is very important as items of uniform can easily become confused, especially after P.E. and swimming sessions.

PROTECTIVE CLOTHING

For Art and Craft lessons, it may be advisable to wear protective clothing over uniform. An old shirt or apron would be a suitable suggestion.
