You can now apply for primary and secondary school places at www.lancashire.gov.uk/schools for those children due to start in September 2024.

It's quick and easy to do and you will receive email confirmation of your application.

You must apply even if you already have siblings in school.

The closing date for secondary applications for September 2024 is on 31 October 2023 and for primary applications 15 January 2024.
