We accept children on an adhoc basis where the staff/pupil ratio allows. Please contact school to confirm a place is available before sending your child in for before and after school club.

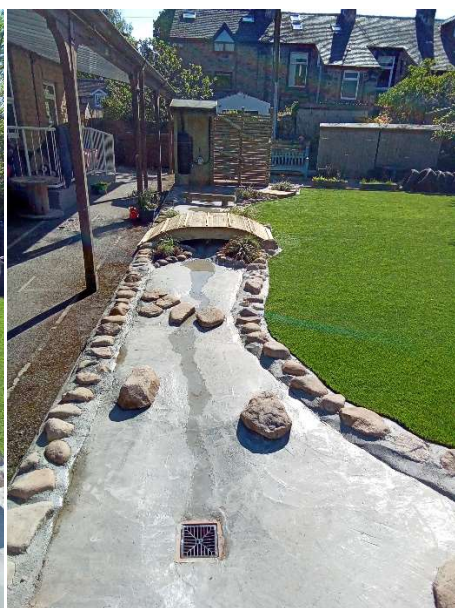
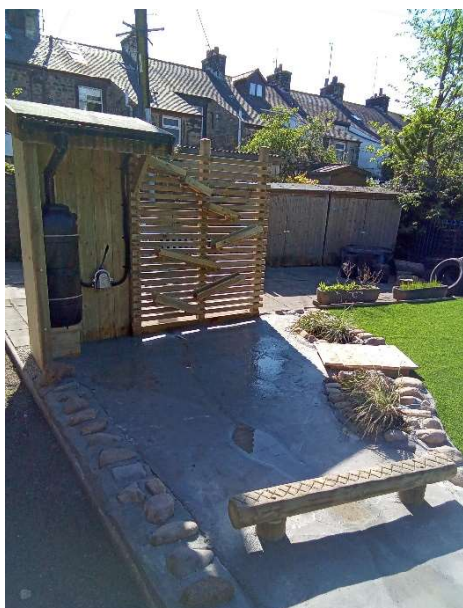
EYFS Outdoor Area
