A copy of the Autumn Winter menu has been shared on ClassDojo and ParentPay. This will start after half term. The menu returns to the normal

three-line choices and has been prepared to offer a varied range of dishes whilst accounting for supply chain issues encountered across the food sector. The menu has been designed to have lower reliance upon frozen products and menu descriptions have been simplified to account for local substitutions to be made. All menu ingredients have been checked for supply chain availability and increased stock holding has been undertaken in advance of the menu introduction. Fresh local produce continues to remain less affected by the national situation and this is reflective of the menu contents.

The cost of lunches for the next half term is £91.80.

After half term children in KS2 will be able to purchase a slice of toast during morning break. The cost continues to be 20p. This can be purchased as 'morning snack' on ParentPay.
