### **Sug Busting**

We continue to receive reports of head lice being spotted, particularly from pupils in Hodder class. We are doing what we can to prevent head to head contact in school and informing parents if we notice any children who are showing any signs of having head lice. Please, with the Easter holidays approaching, can we ask everyone to check their child(ren)'s hair before and during the school holidays. Anyone treated for lice before we break up, then checked over the two weeks of the holidays, should be completely clear upon return. Head lice can still be caught from out of school, but if we do what we can to return to school lice free we can hopefully stop further spreading.
