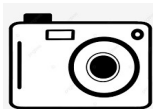
Robinwood – Wyre Class Residential

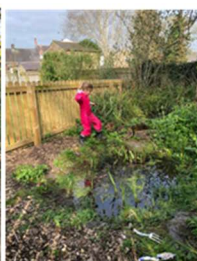
School Dig Day April 2022
