Before and After School Club

As we approach the end of the financial year please can payment for any outstanding invoices be brought up to date – reminders have been sent via ClassDojo. Invoices for the next half term will be issued over the next couple of days.

After school club runs to 5.30pm, and children should be collected no later than this time. As currently applies to Pre-School, a late fee for late collection is to be applied for after school club. The late fee is currently £5 per quarter of an hour.

Staff have been attending various PE courses recently and the advice being given is to go back to changing for PE lessons.
